2016 Quality of Life Summary

THE OHIO RURAL WATER ASSOCIATION SAVED OHIO RURAL COMMUNITIES OVER \$5 MILLION IN 2016

There is no doubt that our Grant Management is excellent.

Given our federal funding in 2016 of about \$600,000, our net benefits to Rural Ohio after grant monies was \$4,476,481!

We are **very effective** in providing the highest quality of help and services for water and wastewater systems with the federal funding we receive.

We are **very efficient** with these monies as we maximized these quality benefits at a rate of over 8-to-1.

To illustrate, for every dollar of federal funding we received in 2016, we provided \$8.46 in real, tangible benefits to rural Ohio.
