## **2018 Quality of Life Summary**

### **THE OHIO RURAL WATER ASSOCIATION SAVED OHIO RURAL COMMUNITIES ALMOST \$3 MILLION IN 2018**

There is no doubt that our Grant Management is excellent. Given our federal funding in 2018 of about \$600,000, our net benefits to Rural Ohio after grant monies was **\$2,278,000**

We are **very effective** in providing the highest quality of help and services for water and wastewater systems with the federal funding we receive.

We are **very efficient** with these monies as we maximized these quality benefits at a rate of 3.8-to-1.

**To illustrate, for every dollar of federal funding we received in 2018, we provided**

**\$3.80 in real, tangible benefits to rural Ohio.**
