Position Title: Water Technician

Job Description: In this position you will be traveling throughout Ohio visiting Water Treatment plants where you will provide technical assistance, training, and advice to system personnel. You will be required to fulfill the contractual requirements of the National Rural Water Association program, which includes traveling to a National Conference and training events that span multiple days. You will be required to assist with annual State Conferences and Expositions. You will also be responsible for recruiting new members and maintaining relations with current members and industry agencies. This position is best suited for individuals who enjoy helping others and continual personal growth.

Experience/Education: Applicants should possess, at a minimum, education equivalent to graduation from high school. Applicants should also possess, at a minimum, the equivalent knowledge of water treatment systems required to obtain an Ohio Class I Water Operators Certification License. The ideal candidate would have multi-year experience in operating and/or managing a rural and/or small municipal water system, as well as possessing knowledge of operations and maintenance to include distribution system experience and well-rounded knowledge of rural and/or small water system operations, management, and financial needs. Experience with writing grants or conducting rate studies is also preferred.

Essential Functions:

1. Provide technical assistance to rural and small municipal water systems by visiting the system
2. Attend ORWA sponsored events as requested by the Executive Director and assist as necessary
3. Attend other meetings and functions relative to water as a representative of ORWA
4. Provide timely information and reports on field operations which are necessary to publicize water technical activities and services, included but not limited to, monthly reports on contractual activities and adherence to the association's goals and objectives
5. Prepare or provide technical information for association publications as requested by the Executive Director
6. Assist in the planning and implementation of annual conventions, training seminars and other special programs
7. Assist the Executive Director as necessary in attaining the goals and objectives of the association
8. Take responsibility for all equipment issued to your care and ensure proper use and maintenance as prescribed by the manufacturer. Records of such maintenance shall be maintained for each piece of equipment
9. Perform other duties assigned by the Executive Director
